As stated in the Articles of Incorporation "the corporation (foundation) is organized exclusively for educational and charitable purposes. The term "charitable purposes" shall be limited to and shall include only religious, charitable, scientific testing for public safety, literary, or educational purposes within the meaning of the terms used in Section 501(C)3 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954..Included among the educational and charitable purposes for which this corporation is organized are the following: the conduct of competitions for organists; the giving of scholarships to deserving organists to assist in their pursuit of higher education; the providing of educational experiences and programs for organists; the commission of appropriate new musical compositions; and, the advancement of professional concerns. The enumeration of the foregoing educational and charitable purposes is not intended to, and shall not operate to limit the educational and charitable activities which may be engaged in and conducted by the corporation."

The mission is to support the organ profession. Over the past twenty years, the Foundation has supported new organ compositions, research and its publication, new books, and specific programming.
